Keene State exists because of its people. From a financial aid counselor to a sustainability studies professor, **faculty and staff bring KSC's mission to life**: to shape today's students into tomorrow's leaders.

Take, for instance, the impact of people like Dr. Patrick Dolenc, an economics professor who built a partnership with the American Democracy Project, a national initiative focused on preparing college students to become the next generation of informed, engaged citizens. The project, which has a network of 250 public colleges and universities, "is about **giving students** the tools they need to make a difference in the world," Dolenc said.

Or the impact of people like professor of public health Dr. Meg Henning, who, along with teaching, conducts ongoing international work in the areas of mobilizing, allocating, and maintaining limited resources to improve health, particularly for mothers and children. "Because of her background, Meg brings a different perspective—a global view," said a colleague. "It really enriches the conversation to be much more inclusive, rather than just thinking about things from a United State or New Hampshire viewpoint."

Or the impact of people like Casey Justice '03, Director of Transitions and Community Living, who ensure that the college is a comforting and engaging home away from home for students. "Someday I want to be like Casey Justice. I want to be that professional walking down the sidewalk that knows everybody," said a residential assistant.
